24.109 <u>Public comment or representation:</u>

<u>Hadham Road Trees</u>: HCC has advised that it has risk assessed the trees and is progressing for action. A resident commented that cars have been crushed, utilities damaged, and people put at risk. The trees are not logged on the HCC tree strategy. Dead wood is lying beneath the trees and many are in poor condition. BT has only just reinstated lines brought down by falling trees, and had to return to remove cabling left across the road.

Hadham Road: highway surface is in very poor condition. It was not

resurfaced at the same time as Standon High Street.

<u>Greenleys, Hadham Road</u>: The wide verge has not been routinely maintained for at least 4 years. Responsibility of Clarion Housing Association. The resident commented that Hadham Road seems to be the 'poor relation' to the

rest of the Parish and this is unacceptable.

On most makes of vehicle, keyless entry can be disabled.

To reduce the risk of theft, ensure car keys (particularly any spare keys) are secured in a secured location using a signal blocking/Faraday pouch when not in use. Hiding the keys in a metal tin can also restrict the signal from vehicle keys.

Your local policing teams are continuing regular patrols in hotspot areas at key times.

Please continue to report suspicious vehicles that may be seen driving around in your area. If you are able to record the MAKE, COLOUR and REGISTRATION number of the vehicle, that would be very helpful.

An extraordinary meeting will be called once the revised quote has been received to enable the Parish Council to review and assess the quotes against each other, and then make recommendation to EHDC which would be its preferred contractor when making application for \$106 monies to be released. A planning application will be required.

Each bench will require the removal and disposal of the existing, a concrete base laid, and a new bench purchased and bolted to the concrete. Cllr Granville recommended we start with the worst but most use bench at the top of the recreation field to establish cost and then budget for further bench changes. A contractor will be sought to complete the works.
